### The Role of the Unit Rep


#### A 2-way link between the OA and your unit

- Attends Lodge & Chapter events
- Schedules OA Unit Elections
- Shows Scout Spirit

### Becoming an OA Unit Rep

Qualifications

- Under 18 years of age
- Appointed by the senior youth leader with adult leader approval

- OA member in good standing & sets a good example to others
- Have good communications skills & be willing to learn



### OA Unit Rep on the Job

Things you can do at unit meetings

- Help other scouts will skills & advancement
- Proudly wear your uniform
- Help plan camping trips and other outings
- Promote Lodge & Chapter events
- Promote summer camp and high adventure opportunities

- Plan unit service projects
- Schedule your unit's annual OA election



### Recognition

#### OA Unit Rep Performance Award

Have served for at least one year as an OA Unit Rep or OA Unit Rep Adviser

- Participate in at least one lodge event during the year.
- Have coordinated (or substantially assisted in coordinating) at least one successful unit election.
- Have coordinated (or substantially assisted in coordinating) at least one unit service project.
- Have coordinated (or substantially assisted in coordinating) at least one camping presentation within your unit which includes coverage of OA High Adventure program opportunities.
